Connect to Autodesk® 360 cloud services for easy sharing, collaboration, and rendering—and showcase your design ideas with illustrations, renderings, 3D presentations, and 3D printing.

All three editions of AutoCAD Design Suite 2013 software include AutoCAD® Raster Design 2013 software for converting scanned images to vector drawings. The Suite features the 2013 releases of each product, which deliver powerful new features and functionality—including capabilities that help streamline the workflow between the products in the Suite and make them easier to use. For example, new Design Suite workflows enable you to automate the creation of Autodesk® 3ds Max® Design 2013 and Autodesk® Showcase® 2013 scenes, directly from AutoCAD 2013 software. With Autodesk® 360 and AutoCAD software, you can now sync your AutoCAD files and settings to the cloud and access your latest files and profile settings from any computer, wherever you are. In addition, Autodesk Showcase 2013 software now supports the ability to publish interactive scenes on web and mobile devices.

3. Installation, Configuration, and Licensing

3.1 Is AutoCAD Design Suite available as a stand-alone and network license?

Yes, AutoCAD Design Suite is available for both stand-alone and network licensing. Licensing is handled through standard Autodesk licensing processes using Autodesk Licensing Manager (ADLM). Customers who purchase multiple network licenses for suites that have common products and are only able to access a subset of prior version copies can get their full prior version entitlement by contacting their reseller or [registering online](#) to have the licenses reissued.

3.2 Do all products in AutoCAD Design Suite need to be used on the same workstation?

Yes, the software applications within an AutoCAD Design Suite license can only be installed on a single computer. They cannot be split across multiple workstations.

3.3 How do I activate my software?

Through the activation and registration interface, you can activate your product 24 hours a day, seven days a week, over the Internet or via email. Either option takes only a few steps to complete and requires your product serial number and registration information.

3.4 What if I have more than one computer? Can I use my software on multiple machines?

Autodesk recognizes that some users may need to operate the software when they are away from their usual work location. To accommodate this need, the product activation technology allows an employee to install the software on a second computer owned by the employee's company, provided it is for use away from the employee's usual work location, the software is used only by that employee and no other, and only one of the two copies of the software is ever in use at any one time. Consult the Autodesk Software License Agreement for details about using the software on a second computer.
